- An applicant with a foreign degree must submit official transcripts for a general evaluation. Names of accredited agencies available upon request.
- The applicant must have an undergraduate minimum grade point average of 2.80 on a 4.00 scale.

- ✓ Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended (foreign transcripts must be accompanied by certified English translations.)
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation - include cover form and letter
- ✓ Philosophy of Education - 500 word essay
- ✓ Updated Professional Resume
